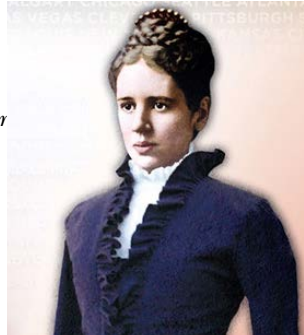

Each year we have three offerings for missions. Each offering is named after a woman who was instrumental in the early days of that particular missions work. The *Lottie Moon Christmas Offering* supports International Missions around the world. The *Mary Hill Davis Offering* funds mission work here in Texas. The *Annie Armstrong Easter Offering* goes to missions all over North America.

The North American Missions Board of our Baptist Convention tells some of Annie's story:

"Each year, we honor the life and advocacy of Annie Walker Armstrong (1850-1938) when we give to the Annie Armstrong Easter Offering® for North American missions. As a tireless servant of God and a contagious advocate and supporter of missions efforts



throughout the world, Annie Armstrong led women to unite in missions endeavors that ultimately led to the formation of Woman's Missionary Union."

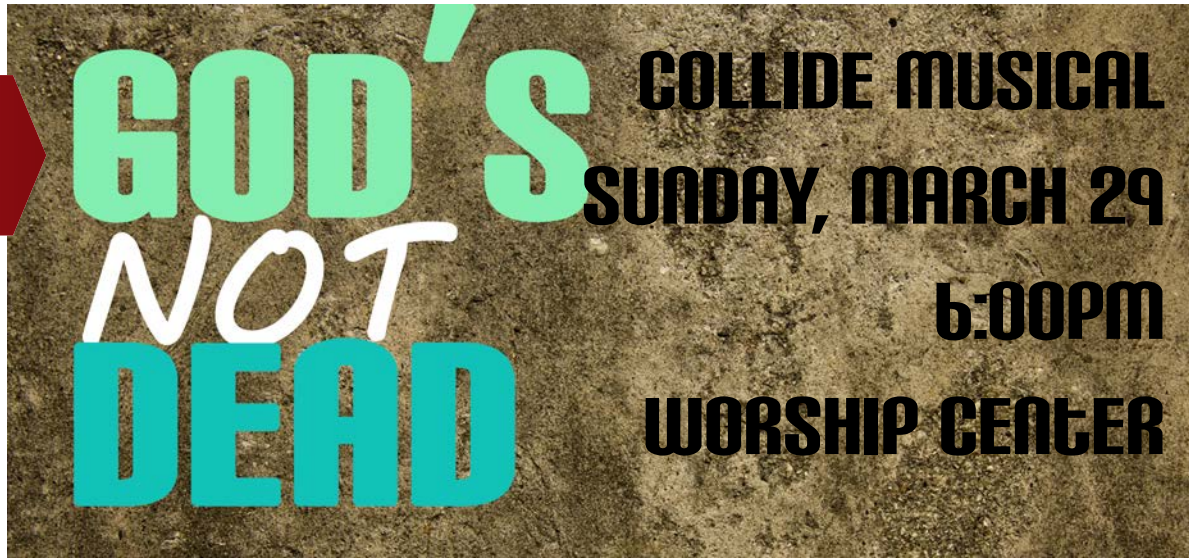
